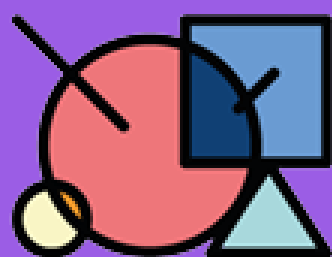

03 Tareas y proceso
